Picnic Shelter Reservation

To reserve a picnic shelter at DuPont State Recreational Forest, contact the Forest Office at (828) 877-6527 ext. 207 or email dupontsf.ncfs@ncagr.org. In the case of a voicemail or email please state your name, contact information, the date and time you would like to come, the shelter you wish to reserve and the number of your group. Below is a complete list of shelters, available reservation times and fees. Reservations must be made at least 72 hours in advance and are not available on federal holidays.

- January
 - Reservations are unavailable
- February 1st through March 31st
 - Reservation times are available Saturday and Sunday
- April 1st through December 31st
 - Reservation times are available Monday through Thursday

If the shelter is available for the date and time you request, you will be asked to submit your payment. Your reservation will not be confirmed until your payment is received. Reservations must be canceled more than 30 days in advance in order to receive a refund. In the case of adverse weather, reservations can be rescheduled. Up to 5 vehicles may be permitted access into DuPont State Recreational Forest for reservations at High Falls, Triple Falls, Lake Dense and Lake Imaging shelters. Vehicles are not permitted to drive to any location in the Forest other than directly to and from the reserved shelter. All vehicles must enter and depart together. The Guion Farm Shelter is located behind the farmhouse on Sky Valley Road and is a short walk from the Guion Farm Access area. Vehicle permits are not issued for Guion Farm Shelter.

There is a public restroom at the High Falls access area and portable toilets at the High Falls and Triple Falls shelters and at the Lake Imaging and Guion Farm parking lots. There is not a toilet located at the Lake Dense shelter. Potable water is available at the High Falls access area only. There is no garbage service; visitors must carry out their own trash. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
