## Site Prep: Drum Chopping

## **Drum Chopping**

- A large, rolling drum with sharp blades is pulled across the ground surface to chop and crush small- to mediumsized woody vegetation and debris.
- Chopping is often used as a preliminary treatment before burning.
- Treatment or control of hardwood sprouts may be needed after chopping.
