Environmental Quality Incentives Program (NRCS)	Site prep, tree planting, timber stand improvement, prescribed burning, and more	Any land on which agricultural commodities, livestock, or forest- related products are produced.	Receive applications year- round: batched and ranked once per year	Reimbursement of 50% to over 100% of actual cost, may not exceed \$450,000 for all EQIP contracts in a time period	10 - 15 year practice life for most forestry practices
Conservation Stewardship Program (NRCS)	Site prep, tree planting, timber stand improvement, prescribed burning, and more	Agricultural lands, cropland, grassland, pastureland, rangeland, and NIPF. At least two priority resource concerns must be met at time of application. Must add one additional priority concern by end of contract.	Receive applications year- round: batched and ranked once per year	Reimbursement of 50% to over 100% of actual cost, minimum annual payment \$4,000, maximum annual payment \$200,000	All forestland controlled by participant at time of application must be enrolled in CSP. Contract length of five years
Emergency Forest Restoration Program (FSA)	Site prep, tree planting, and more	NIPF located in county affected by a given natural disaster (not in CRP).	30 - 60 day period after EFRP is activated in that county	75% of net out-of-pocket costs, minimum \$1,000 payment, maximum \$500,000 payment per disaster event	Contract for lifespan of practice, typically 10 years.
