For medical emergencies in the forest call 911. State your name, your location and the nature of the emergency. Cell phone coverage is limited in the forest. Group leaders should check coverage to determine locations for making emergency calls. For non emergency assistance call the forest office at 877-6527.

Commercial users of DuPont State Recreational Forest (DSRF) must give adequate consideration to the inherent dangers of providing commercial services in a remote outdoor environment. Hazards include, but are not limited to: stinging insects, steep slopes, slippery rock surfaces, snake bites, fallen limbs, and dangers associated with severe weather events.

Commercial users must have the ability to provide first aid for victims. Remote carry outs in the forest can take up to two hours and result in transport by air ambulance to trauma centers in Greenville, SC or Asheville, NC.

Completion of the information below will satisfy the Medical Plan requirement for Tier I and Tier II commercial use. Tier III commercial users must complete an ICS 206-CG before a permit can be issued.
