Cover letters & resumes must be received between 8:00 AM Jan. 2, 2024 and 5:00 P.M. Jan. 31, 2024.

These internships are not open to previously selected NCFS summer interns. Individuals that may represent groups currently under-represented in the NCFS's workforce are strongly encouraged to apply. The N.C. Forest Service has a successful history of working with interns, with many becoming some of our organization's leaders.
